Spray Application	Payable per hour to painters performing spray application other than in a properly constructed booth.	\$ 0.73 per hour
Roof Repairs	Payable per hour to employees (other than roof slaters & tilers) performing repairs to roofs. Special rates apply for roof slaters and tilers working at heights over 15m. See Award for further details	\$ 0.91 per hour

Insulation	Payable to employees handling or employees in the immediate vicinity to charcoal, pumice, granulated cork, silicate of cotton, insulwool, slag wool, limpet fibre, vermiculite or other insulating materials.	\$ 0.91 per hour
Hot Work	Payable to employees who work in a place where the temperature has been raised artificially to between 46 degrees and 54 degrees Celsius.	\$ 0.73 per hour
	Payable to employees who work in a place where the temperature has been raised artificially to above 54 degrees Celsius.	\$ 0.91 per hour
Cold Work	Payable to employees who work in a place where the temperature has been lowered artificially to less than 0 degrees Celsius.	\$ 0.73 per hour
Confined Space	Payable to employees required to work in confined spaces	\$ 0.91 per hour
Swing Scaffold	Payable to employees required to work on any scaffolding suspended by rope or cable, bosun's chair or a suspended scaffolding requiring hooks.	See Award

Height Work	Payable to employees working on structures at a heights of more than 9 metres, where fixed support not less than 75cm wide is not provided.	\$ 0.66 per hour

Waste Disposal	Payable to employees who work at a landfill or garbage tips.	\$ 1.52 per hour

Explosive Powered Tools	Payable per hour for the day to employees operating explosive powered tools.	\$ 1.73 per day
Grindstone	Payable to carpenter or joiner where a grindstone or wheel is not available.	\$ 7.76 per week
Hydraulic Hammer	Payable to operator of a hydraulic hammer attached to an excavator.	\$ 1.23 per hour

Air-Conditioning/Refrigeration	Payable to air-conditioning and refrigeration tradesperson or mechanics. Employees who receive this allowances are not entitled to certain working condition allowances. See award for more details.	\$ 68.13 per week
Scaffolder/Rigger Certificate	Payable to a tradesperson who is that holder of a scaffolding or rigging certificate engaged on work that requires that certificate.	\$ 0.73 per hour

Cleaning Down	Payable to an employee required to clean down bricks using acid or corrosive substances.	\$ 0.66 per hour
Refractory Bricklaying	Bricklayer	\$ 2.27 per hour

Heavy blocks	Payable to employee laying blocks weighing over 5.5kg and under 9kg	\$ 0.73 per hour

Bitumen Work	Payable to employees handling hot bitumen or asphalt	\$ 0.91 per hour

Cutting Machine	Payable to the bricklayer operating the cutting machine.	\$ 0.91 per hour
Furnace Work	Payable to employees in the construction, alteration or repairs to boilers, flues, furnaces, retorts, kilns, ovens, ladles and similar refractory work.	\$ 1.93 per hour
Acid Work	Payable to employees in the construction, or repairs to acid furnaces, acid stills, acid towers and all other acid resisting brickwork.	\$ 1.93 per hour
Cutting Tiles	Payable for hours worked to employees cutting tiles by electric saw.	\$ 0.91 per hour
Dry Polish of Tiles	Payable to employees performing dry polishing of tile where machines are used.	\$ 0.91 per hour

Pile Driving	Payable to a mobile crane operator in excess of 15 ton required to perform pile driving (including extraction).	\$ 17.25 per day
Dual Lift	Payable to operator where two or more lifts or cranes are required for any lift	\$ 3.68 per day
